Periodontist Dr. Ryan Schure, the newest member of the PA team, has amassed an impressive list of accomplishments in his career. He has completed his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree and Masters of Science in periodontology, both at the University of Toronto, where he also works as a lecturer with the department of continuing dental education, and as a member of the undergraduate admissions committee. During his studies, Dr. Schure researched the relationship between cardiovascular diseases and periodontal diseases, and his findings have been published and presented internationally.

Dr. Schure's drive to succeed can be traced back to his upbringing and the values his parents instilled in him at a young age. "Whatever I was doing, my parents wanted me to put in 100 percent effort, and to always finish what I started. My motto is that things tend to work out, but of course, things likely tend to work out because of my hard work and dedication."

From a young age, Dr. Schure found himself



drawn to roles that involved working with people - and helping them. Whether as a camp counselor, a swimming instructor, or a lifeguard, Dr. Schure has always sought out jobs that allow him to build relationships with those around him. 
